Principal's Report

Chair's Report

- 1). The following recommendations have been made for 2008-2009.
 - a). Electronic device verbage taken from FCAT manual in reference to testing will be placed in the Code of Conduct.
- Ms. Jusevic had some concerns that parents were not being made aware.
- b). Use of cell phones on buses will only be allowed during life to safety issues.
 - c). Every student from middle through high school must wear ID badges. Discipline committees will decide the consequences. Our discipline committee will also look at temporary IDs.
 - d). Students will be allowed to wear tank tops as long as they wear a jacket over the tank top.
- 2). Safety and Security is trying for a 50,000 grant to make it possible for parents to update Virtual Counselor and Parent Link to call two numbers.

New Business

Mr. McIntyre stated BTU is opposing the Property Tax Amendment because it will take money away from education. Ms. Dilgen reported on January 24th, 2008 PTSA is sponsoring a financial aid night. The target group are Jr's and Sr's. A call out to parents
